



COACH CODE OF CONDUCT

As an Inclusive United Coach, I will:

-  **Display and promote high standards of behaviour. Be polite, kind, understanding and supportive to all participants, my colleagues and to opponents, officials and all others involved in Inclusive United.**
-  **Always be on time and arrive half an hour before the session starts to ensure everything is ready and set up.**
-  **Always be organised and prepared. I will plan the session in advance and ensure I have all the correct equipment ready.**
-  **Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in Inclusive United, regardless of their race, gender, religion, ability or background.**
-  **Always be respect to everyone and respect match officials' (or club officials') decisions during a match or training session. Never engage in public criticism of others or verbally abuse or argue with others. Never engage in offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour. Not bully, intimidate or harass anyone.**
-  **Be aware that everyone is different and make reasonable adjustments as needed. I will give instructions to players in short, clear, sentences and check that everyone has understood and use visuals or signs if necessary.**
-  **Follow all Inclusive United and FA safeguarding and codes of conduct at all times and ensure a safe environment.**
-  **I will ask for help or support from my colleagues, line managers or the Inclusive United Director of People if I need to discuss anything.**
